Application To Join An Agricultural And Forestal District (Application Fee: \$100.00) Agricultural and Forestal Districts are a voluntary program which promote Agriculture in Culpeper County. Each district is established for an eight (8) year cycle, after which time it will be reviewed for renewal purposes.

Application To Withdraw From An Agricultural and Forestal District (Application Fee: \$350.00 plus mailing & advertising costs) Applicants may apply to withdraw from a District which has not yet reached the end of its eight (8) year cycle.

Application To Create A New Agricultural and Forestal District (Application Fee: \$250.00) Each district shall be a minimum of 200 acres (core) consisting of one or more contiguous parcels, a parcel not part of the core must be located within one mile of the core of the district. Once created a new district will begin an eight (8) year cycle, after which time it will be reviewed for renewal purposes.

NOTICE
